General Information

Our Studie

We are located at Glengowrie Uniting Church, 33 Butler Crescent, Glengowrie, South Australia. We have 2 studios (Main Hall and Hall 1) a Singing Room and a large stage that we utilise for some of our performances. Our Main Hall has built in Ballet Barres, Mirrors and new flooring and fans.

Hot Weather Policy

In the event of extreme hot weather, StarLite classes will go ahead but where possible, classes will move into the smaller, air-conditioned studio (Hall 1). Class content is significantly modified, and children will stop for a drink break at least every 10-15 minutes. Students are encouraged to bring a named drink bottle to EVERY lesson.

Enrolments

We only accept new students into our general classes before 1st August as after this point concert preparations are well underway, and students are already learning the content for our concert. Please note that Stage Stars Classes do **NOT** take any new students in Term 2 as this is when Stage Stars are given scripts to learn for our Cabaret (We **DO** however accept new students in the first 2 weeks of Term 3).

Uniform

Students are expected to wear the correct uniform which is detailed in this booklet. Uniform is available for purchase from our studio or any dance retailer.

Website

All Students have access to the 'Students Area' on our website (password will be issued upon enrolment). We upload tips and tools to helps our students with their classes all their concert music so that they can practice at home.

Fundraising

At least one fundraising event will be held every term, and all students are expected to participate in these events. You will be informed of the details for each event. All money raised goes towards our costumes and concerts and allows us to keep our costume fee to a minimum.

Open Dåýs

Open Day classes are held at the normal class times, but we open our doors for you to watch. This enable parents, friends, and family to see what we have been learning and how students have improved. Reminders about these days will be given as each Open Day draws close.

Pårent Notices

Newsletters and notices are sent out to parents throughout the year. As we like to be environmentally conscious, we keep the paper notices to a minimum. All information will be added to our website and a SMS will be sent to parents with a link to the information when it becomes available.

Concerts

We have several performances every year. Depending on the level and class students are invited to perform in the following: -

- Our **Mid-Year Concert** allows our Pre-Intermediate, Intermediate, Senior and Advanced Dance Students (excluding Acro dance) an extra performance allowing them to showcase their technique on a professional stage. (Please note that Singers and Stage Stars will not participate in this concert as they will be performing in their Cabaret at the End of Term 2).
- Our **Cabaret Evening**, held on our very own stage at our studio, is for our Stage Stars and Singing students to perform their acting and singing skills in a more intimate environment.
- The Performance Troup **Musical** is a professional level musical theatre show which is performed by our Stage Stars performance Troup at the end of the year.
- Our big **End of Year Concert** celebrates what we have accomplished in the year. This Performance is for all Students except the Stage Stars Performance Troup.

Stårkite Elåsses

Little Stars (3-5 years)

This class provides a basic introduction to dance and movement skills by combining simple ballet technique with funky jazz moves and fun games. Children have the opportunity to develop coordination and musicality skills as well as gain confidence in a friendly, imaginative, and fun-filled environment.

Jazz (from 5 years)

A timeless staple and perfect dance style to get a taste of all techniques. This exciting mix is a very popular class! Students learn many different genres of Jazz dance, including classic Jazz, Modern, Broadway, Lyrical and Street Funk. As Students progress into Senior and Advanced level classes they are also invited to perform Solos and in smaller group pieces for our Concerts to help them gain confidence and experience the spotlight on stage.

Ballet (from 5 years)

Ballet is an integral part of dance and whatever style a child chooses to undertake; ballet technique provides the foundation for that style. Students wishing to strengthen their technique in other areas of dance are strongly encouraged to attend a Classical class. Our Beginner/Junior Ballet Class is suitable for ages 5-9 and as your child grows more confident in their Ballet technique they will move up into Junior/Pre-Intermediate Ballet.

Tap (from 5 years)

Tap classes are designed to develop rhythm, style and sound. Students will learn a variety of tap styles from Broadway to Rhythm tap. Exercises focus on building flexibility of the knee and ankles, coordination, and speed of movement. The class emphasis is on developing proper tap technique, producing clear tap sounds, and having fun.

Hip Hop (from 5 years)

Our Hip Hop syllabus from ATOD will focus on correct technique with the need for individuality and personal style. This is street dance at its best. Learn Crumping, Locking and Breaking just like your favourite Hip Hop stars!

Acro Dance (from 7 years)

During Acro dance classes your child will be taught and trained in skills such as flexibility, strength, and control to perform tricks, balances, and tumbling. Acro dance students will now have the chance to perform a dance in our end of year concert to showcase their Acro skills.

Stage Stars (from 7 years)

Stage Stars will help your child grow in confidence, self-esteem and creativity while developing verbal, social and listening skills. This class focuses on all aspects of the stage including acting, singing and movement. We will work on drama skits and Musical Theatre numbers along with character development and confidence building. We will also have a lot of fun along the way!

Stage Stars Performance Troup (Age 12+)

This is an invitation-only class for advanced and experienced musical Theatre Performers. Admission to the class is only available in Term 1, and performers will work the whole year towards putting on a professional level Musical show.

Contemporary (from 9 years)

Contemporary or 'Lyrical' is a hybrid of Ballet, Jazz, Lyrical and Modern dance. It's a ballet-based technique that allows a greater range of movement which encourages self-expression, natural movements, and personal interpretation.

Ballet Pointe (Senior/Advanced Level)

We are now offering Pointe classes for our Senior/Advanced Ballet Students who have the required strength to participate in this class. Entry into this class is by assessment. Advanced Students who wish to strengthen towards pointe in the future may join with this class on demi points.

Private Dance Tuition (from 6 years)

Private Dance students enjoy one on one personalised coaching with experienced teachers, which is specific to their needs. Fantastic for students wishing to develop further, prepare for auditions or just wish to gain confidence and excel their technique.

Private Singing Tuition (from 6 years)

Private Singing students enjoy one on one personalised coaching with experienced teachers, which is specific to their needs. Fantastic for students wishing to develop further, prepare for auditions or just wish to gain confidence and have fun. All singing students have several opportunities to perform throughout the year on stage at our Cabaret Evening and End of Year Concerts. Students also have the opportunity to record the songs learned throughout the year to give them the experience of using professional microphones and recording equipment.

PLEASE NOTE CHANGE TO FEE STRUCTURE

** The Concert Levy is replacing our previous Music Fee, Costume fee and Media Package. The Concert Levy is compulsory for all participating students and is divided into 3 payments which is added to your invoice in Terms 1,2 & 3. If you join partway through the year the full Concert Levy will still be payable and a catchup payment will be charged in Terms 2 & 3. This Levy covers all Term 4 Concert Costumes (which students can keep after the concerts), access to download the professional filmed footage from our 2024 concerts, the cost of licensing & the use of our Students Area on our website (password will be issued upon enrolment) along with a Trophy upon completion of the dance year.

*** Families will receive a reduced rate (\$75 per dance class or \$45 for Singing) for the Concert Levy if they attend 5 of more classes per week per family.

Term and Conditions of Enrolment

Class Fees: -

- 1. StarLite has a strict no payment no class policy. Invoices for your first term will be due two weeks after student's commencement of class. Invoices for the following terms will be due prior to the commencement of Term. Students will not be able to participate in classes where fees are outstanding.
- 2. We are happy to arrange payment plans for those who need assistance, but this must be arranged prior to class commencement, or the student will not be admitted into class.
- 3. Once enrolment forms have been submitted, invoices will be sent out via email. (Please do not send payment with enrolment form).
- 4. Payment for classes can be made by submitting cash or cheque with invoice remittance slip into the StarLite drop box at the hall or by Direct Deposit into the account listed on the invoice.
- 5. Students who undertake 2 or more classes are entitled to 10% discount off their class fees. Discounts do not apply to Private Lessons.
- 6. Families with 3 or more enrolled children are entitled to an additional 5% off their fees. Please note that this again does not apply to Private Lessons.
- 7. The Sports Vouchers for Schools program is available at StarLite Dance Academy. If you choose to use your Voucher the forms are available on the front desk and must be submitted before the invoice due date. Any amount over the voucher allowance is to be paid by the due date and if the voucher is not honoured by the program you will still be liable for fees and will be contacted by us.
- 8. Please note that all fees and the Costume Levy is non-refundable if classes are missed and/or participation ceases.

Concert Levy: -

- 1. All students are required to pay a Concert Levy which is replacing our Costume fee, Music Fee and Media Package.
- 2. The Concert Levy is compulsory for all participating students and is divided into 3 payments which is added to your invoice in Terms 1,2 & 3.
- 3. If you jin partway through the year the full Concert Levy is still payable in full and a catch up payment will be charged.
- 4. The Levy covers all Term 4 Concert Costumes (Which students can keep after the concerts), access to download the professionally filmed footage from this years concerts, the cost of licensing & the use of our Students Area on our website (password will be issued upon enrolment) along with a Trophy upon completion of the dance year.
- 5. We make and supply costumes for all students regardless of whether they perform in our end of Year concert or not. Pleae also note we will NOT be taking photos of students in their costumes this year but there will be time for the students to have pictures in costume at the theatre after the concert.
- 6. Stage Stars and Singers will be supplied with a costume to borrow for the Cabaret performance. They will get to keep their costumes for the End of Year Concert. Singing and Senior/Advanced Solo/Small group performance costumes will also be borrowed from the Starlite Costumes for the end of year concert so as to keep the Costume fees low for families.
- 7. Families will receive a reduced rate (\$75 per dance class or \$45 for Singing) for the Concert Levy if they attend 5 of more classes per week per family.

General Terms and Conditions of Enrolment: -

- 1. Enrolment is for the full year.
- 2. StarLite reserves the right to alter/adjust the timetable, staffing and class sizes we have a minimum requirement of 4 students per class for a class to go ahead.
- 3. If a student wishes to discontinue lessons, written notification must be received by Week 10 of the currect term to avoid further charges.
- 4. Full term fees shall apply to a student wishing to discontinue lessons after the commencement of the term.
- 5. Parents are asked to advise the school if a student is not attending class due to illness, or for any other reason and classes **cannot** be made up at another time, if absence occurs.
- 6. StarLite staff are only responsible for children enrolled with the school and during their scheduled class time and rehearsal or performance periods. Children must not be left unsupervised before or after classes.
- 7. Parents/guardians must read all information and newsletters thoroughly and contact Miss Caroline immediately if any issues arise in regard to attendance at classes, rehearsals and performances.
- 8. It is expected that all students will contribute to fundraising activities in some way. Money raised throughout the year goes towards theatre hire, costumes, lighting and sound, photography and trophies.
- 9. If a child has any injuries or medical conditions, you will indicate this on your enrolment form as well as the appropriate treatment and care for these. Any information regarding student well-being must be communicated to and/or via Miss Caroline.
- 10. StarLite and Glengowrie Uniting Church shall not be responsible for any injury sustained by parents, family, friends or students whilst on the premises of Glengowrie Uniting Church or associated venue for rehearsals/performances.
- 11. StarLite shall not be responsible for any injury sustained by students whilst participating in classes or performances. StarLite staff have permission to seek medical assistance if necessary and you agree to pay any costs incurred.
- 12. Students must attend all lessons in the correct uniform and with their Hair tied back neatly.
- 13. The school shall not be held responsible for the loss or damage of property. All shoes and clothing should be clearly labelled.
- 14. Permission is given to photograph, film or video students to be used for studio publicity (including on our website and social media) or memorabilia (no names are published with images). Please notify Miss Caroline in writing if permission is not granted.
